The estate was recently purchased by the Berkeley Group who intend to develop much of the mansion and Green Belt grounds into housing.

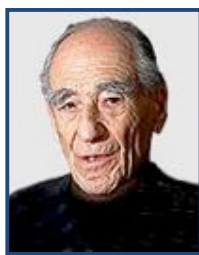
Support our campaign for the establishment of a **national museum** within the Mansion House to pay tribute to this extraordinary history & pay homage to the unsung heroes who worked there.
